Week 1 - God Creates the World

Wednesday, September 11, 2024

Read **Genesis 1:1-25**. How was God able to do such a big job? Why did He make the world to include so many different shapes, sizes, colors, smells, sounds, tastes, and textures? What does this tell us about what God is like?

Read **Psalm 19:1-4** & **Romans 1:20**.

Because God is the one, eternal, glorious God who created all things, how should you act toward Him? Who created you? Who do you belong to? Read **Revelation 4:11**. What would it look like in your life to show that God is worth more to you than anything else?

Activity: Read **Psalm 148** and then plan to go to a park or nature center. Walk along the trails and point out specific things to look at, listen to, smell, and touch. Then turn your observations into praise refrains such as "Praise the Lord, you fuzzy squirrels. Praise Him, you purple crawling beetles. Praise God, you tall, shady tree. Praise Him, you singing sparrow. Praise the Lord, you warm wind," and so on. How could you praise God as you walk along?

Memory Verse: "The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork." (Psalm 19:1)
