

THE GOSPEL CERTAINTY: Luke 1:1-4 ESV

Why did Luke write this Gospel?

- Verse 4 - That we might have certainty of the things of Christ.
- FINAL PURPOSE OF LUKE: [Luke 19:10](#) - "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

How did Luke write this Gospel?

- Verse 3 - He followed all things closely, for some time past (from the start/from the beginning), orderly (chronologically).
- Verse 1 - He sought out the many eyewitnesses of the account of Jesus

Who is Luke?

- [Colossians 4:14](#) - Luke is a physician who loves people...especially the lowly and outcast
- [Philemon 1:23-24](#) - Luke loves missions...constantly showing us that Jesus came for the whole world (all the nations).
- [2 Timothy 4:10-11](#) - Luke is a disciple of Jesus Christ...one who understood the cost of what it means to follow Jesus with his life.

"Luke the disciple will help you become more willing in your sacrifice. Luke the missionary will move you to labor for God's Kingdom. Luke the physician will help you to love people more. And Luke the historian will make you certain about it all."
